# Parking information

Although Tower Bridge does not have its own car park, there are plenty of car parks located nearby. Please find details below.

Note: Tower Bridge is a Red Route and there can be no stopping at any time.

## City of London car parks

#### **Minories**

Located on Mansell Street is a few minutes walk north of Tower Bridge, no coaches are permitted in this car park.

Open seven days a week, 24 hours a day, there are 320 spaces available including five disabled spaces.

#### **Tower Hill**

Located on Lower Thames Street, opposite Sugar Quay, a short walk away from the Exhibition.

Open 7 days a week, 24 hours a day, there are 110 spaces available including five disabled spaces.

## Other parking

## The Tower Hotel car park

Located on the north bank of the river next to Tower Bridge.

## NCP car parks

There are various NCP car parks located close to Tower Bridge – London Snowfields is located on Kipling Street near London Bridge Station. There are several car parks in the City and in Southwark all of which are located 15–20 minutes' walk away from the Bridge. For information: ncp.co.uk

# **On-street parking**

City of London (north side of the Bridge). Maximum stay 2 hours (£1 coins only). Electric vehicles free.

## Coach drop-off points

Coaches can drop-off and collect from the Tower Hill car park, where it is free for 15 minutes. Many coaches also drop off and collect from Tooley Street.
